### Level A

Для визначення кількості вживаються неозначені займенники **some/any** (декілька, трохи), **no** (ніякий, жодний).

Вони вживаються на позначення злічуваних іменників у множині й незлічуваних іменників.

**Some** вживається у стверджувальних реченнях.

There are pictures on the walls. I like **some** of them.

**Any** вживається замість **some** у питальних і заперечних реченнях.

I need apples for the pie. Have you got **any**?

Is there **any** water in the bottle? — Sorry, there isn't **any**.

**No** може вживатися в заперечних реченнях замість **not any**.

There are **no** flowers in the vase.

There is **no** water in the bottle.

**Some** може вживатися в питальних реченнях у тому випадку, якщо ці речення висловлюють пропозицію чи прохання.

I have made a cake. Would you like **some**? (пропозиція)

I like ice cream. Can I have **some**, please? (прохання)

**Any** вживається у стверджувальних реченнях у значенні «будь-який».

We have got many books to read. You can take **any** of them.
